Ultramar have always been very proud of the landscaping at their service stations across the country, but there has always been a concern regarding the control of weeds. The weed growth at these installations needed to be removed on a regular basis and some had reached the point beyond control. With maintenance costs rising, Ultramar needed a long term solution, and after much research, they opted for Biobarrier.



Biobarrier is rolled out over the desired areas.



Bushes and shrubs are arranged in the desired planting location.



An opening is cut in Biobarrier, the holes are dug, and the bushes are then planted in the soil. 1" of soil is placed around bushes. Mulch is added to a maximum thickness of 3".



Biobarrier is placed as a "tree skirt" around each tree.



Biobarrier is inserted under the fence.



The final step is to add sod and mulch in and around the plantation beds and trees.



Biobarrier's performance is guaranteed by the manufacturer for 15 years, but you can expect it to last for 25 and even 30 years!
